

HYLAND STREET TRAFFIC DIVERSION PROJECT

- Traffic Revisions Completed -

Construction work to install the permanent traffic diversion structures at the intersections of Hyland and Bastian streets with Hoffman Hill Boulevard has been completed.

The traffic diverters and regulatory signage has been installed to direct "through" traffic traveling between McNeil Street and Hoffman Hill Boulevard to use these primary access streets, and to reduce traffic flows on the local access streets of Hyland and Bastian.

In the north-bound direction (coming down Hoffman Hill Blvd), vehicles are restricted from turning right onto Hyland and Bastian streets, directing the "through" traffic flows to continue to McNeil Street.

In the south-bound direction (coming up Hoffman Hill Blvd), local traffic may turn left onto Hyland or Bastian streets; "through" traffic flows will continue up Hoffman Hill Blvd.

Drivers are asked to adhere to all regulatory traffic control signage and to obey the posted 25 MPH speed limits throughout our residential areas.
